SOVEREIGN CHAPTER BY-LAWS

By-Laws of the Sovereig	n Chapter	. No

1. Title

The name of the Chapter is the Sovereign Chapter, No, on the register of the Supreme Council of the Thirty-third Degree of the Ancient and Accepted Scottish Rite for Australia.

2. Ritual (insert one only of these clauses as appropriate *)

* The Chapter works the Christian 18° Ritual published by the Supreme Council for Australia, as revised from time to time.

OR

* The Chapter works the Universal 18° Ritual published by the Supreme Council for Australia, as revised from time to time.

OR

* The Chapter works the 18° Ritual published by the Supreme Council for England and Wales. (Restricted to ex-English Chapters which came across in 2004)

3. Time and Place of Meeting

4. Summons for Meeting

The summons for each meeting of the Chapter shall be sent by the Recorder to be received by the members of the Chapter at least seven clear days before the date of the meeting. Where due notice of any matter is required by the Regulations or these By-Laws it shall be given by insertion in the summons for the meeting.

5. Election of Most Wise Sovereign, Treasurer, Outer Guard and Auditor/s

6. Fees and Subscriptions

- a) The Chapter shall, once in each year, determine what fees and subscriptions shall be payable for the ensuing year and those fees and subscriptions shall be included in the minutes of that meeting. The fees and subscriptions so determined shall include the prescribed fees and dues payable to Supreme Council.
- b) The annual subscription shall be due and payable at the meeting. Each new member shall be presented with a schedule of fees and subscriptions when admitted.
- c) A candidate for Perfection and a Joining, Re-joining or Affiliating member shall be liable to pay only a pro-rata Chapter annual subscription in regard to the then current year to be calculated with reference to the number of remaining regular meetings of the year including the meeting of his Perfection or acceptance as a member.

7. Financial Year

The financial year of the Chapter shall close on the day of in each year and audited accounts shall be presented to the Chapter as soon as practicable thereafter.

8. Bank Account (insert one of these clauses only, as appropriate *)

9. Extraordinary payments

No payment other than for ordinary purposes shall be made from the funds of the Chapter without the sanction of the Chapter granted by a resolution for which notice shall be given in the Chapter summons, except in cases of emergency when the Most Wise Sovereign may authorise a payment to an amount not exceeding dollars but he must report the matter to the Chapter at its next regular meeting.

10. Arrears of Subscriptions

Should a member be months/years in arrears with his subscriptions he shall thereupon cease to be a member of the Chapter and can only become a member again by regular proposition and ballot. The Chapter shall require payment of arrears as a condition precedent to his re-acceptance.

11. Honorary Membership

Election to honorary membership, where the member has been proposed in accordance with the Regulations, shall be only by the unanimous vote of the members present at the meeting and voting.

12. Ballot

No person can be Perfected or admitted a member of the Chapter if, on the ballot *___ black balls are cast against him. (*The Regulations offer the option of two or three)

13. Property of Chapter

All property of the Chapter is vested in the Most Wise Sovereign, Prelate, and Generals for the time being, in trust for the Chapter and shall be insured against all risks, if appropriate.

14. Amendments of By-Laws

Amendments of these By-Laws can only be made in accordance with the Regulations of Supreme Council.

15. Resignation

Any member wishing to resign from the Chapter may do so by notice in writing to the Recorder and payment of all sums then due by him to the Chapter. The notice of resignation shall be placed before the Chapter at its next regular meeting. A clearance certificate shall be issued if the member is then in good standing in the Chapter.

Resignation shall date from the date of the letter of resignation unless otherwise specified therein.

16. Change of residence

A member who has changed his place of abode or other contact details (such as phone, email or mobile number), shall without delay notify the Recorder of his new place of abode or his revised contact details.

17. Regulations of the Supreme Council

These By-Laws shall be subservient to and must comply with the Regulations of the Supreme Council for Australia, as amended from time to time. Any matter not specifically dealt with in the By-Laws or Regulations shall be referred to the Supreme Council for decision or interpretation.

18. Application of Income and Property

- a) The income and property of the Sovereign Chapter wheresoever derived shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects for which the Sovereign Chapter is established, namely to cultivate the Degrees of the Ancient & Accepted Scottish Rite from the 4th to 18th, both inclusive, as provided by the Regulations. The Sovereign Chapter is specifically prohibited by the Regulations from making any distribution whether in money, property or otherwise to its members.
- b) In the event that the Sovereign Chapter shall at any time be dissolved or wound up or otherwise cease to exist, then its property, assets and funds shall, after payment thereout of the expenses of such dissolution or winding up and of the realisation of any such property and assets and also of all debts and liabilities for which the Sovereign Chapter shall be responsible, be paid, transferred and made over to the Supreme Council and shall be applied by it as provided by the appropriate Regulation.
